## **Terrance Hines, MD, FAAFP, sworn in as TAFP Treasurer**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS — Terrance Hines, MD, FAAFP, of Austin, Texas, was sworn in as treasurer of the Texas Academy of Family Physicians during the 2021 Annual Session and Primary Care Summit in The Woodlands. Hines assumed his duties Nov. 6 during the TAFP Business and Awards Lunch.

Hines is currently the Executive Director and Chief Medical Officer for University Health Services at the University of Texas at Austin. He received his undergraduate and medical degrees from Texas A&M University and completed his training at John Peter Smith Hospital Family Medicine Residency Program where he also served as President of the House Staff. He then spent 10 years at Baylor Scott & White Health in Austin, where he ultimately became Assistant Division Director for Primary Care. He has enjoyed teaching future physicians as adjunct assistant professor at Texas A&M College of Medicine and affiliate faculty at Dell Medical School at UT Austin.

During his year as TAFP Treasurer, Hines will serve as chair of the Finance Committee to review the Academy's income and expenses. He will work with other officers to lead the Academy: Immediate Past President and Board Chair Amer Shakil, MD, of Dallas; President Mary Nguyen, MD, of Castroville; President-elect Emily Briggs, MD, of New Braunfels; and Parliamentarian Lindsay Botsford, MD, of Houston.
